Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

Unison: **And also with you.**

Celebrant: Lift up your hearts.

Unison: **We lift them to the Lord.**

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

Unison: **It is right to give our thanks and praise!**

Celebrant: Creator God, we are amazed at your holy and diverse creation. You made us in your

image and offered us every good gift in the garden, yet we took for ourselves forbidden fruit, thinking we could be like you. In so doing, we rejected your intended diversity for us, a human sin that we still cannot shake. Prophets came through the ages to help us mend our ways. And still we fought and tried to conquer others to make all manner of nations live like one another. Jesus came and finally showed us how to truly love. He sat with sinners and tax collectors, he touched diseased bodies with gentleness, he lifted others from their deathbed and, even with his dying breath, promised rest to a thief on the cross.
