A Lenten Water Challenge: Living Generously, Serving Boldly

- Rev'd Gary Noonan invites us to a simple and meaningful Lenten practice: for the 40 days of Lent, consider drinking only clean tap water and donating the money you would normally spend on other beverages to support the building of clean water wells in Africa through our mission partner, **Marion Medical Mission**.
- Skipping the morning coffee run, the drink with a drive-through meal, or an evening adult beverage can help us become more mindful of how much we spend on beverages—and how blessed we are to have access to clean water. This practice invites us to stand in solidarity with communities who do not share that same access and to support faithful partners working to provide life-giving water for all of God's children.
