CASAVANT PIPE ORGAN

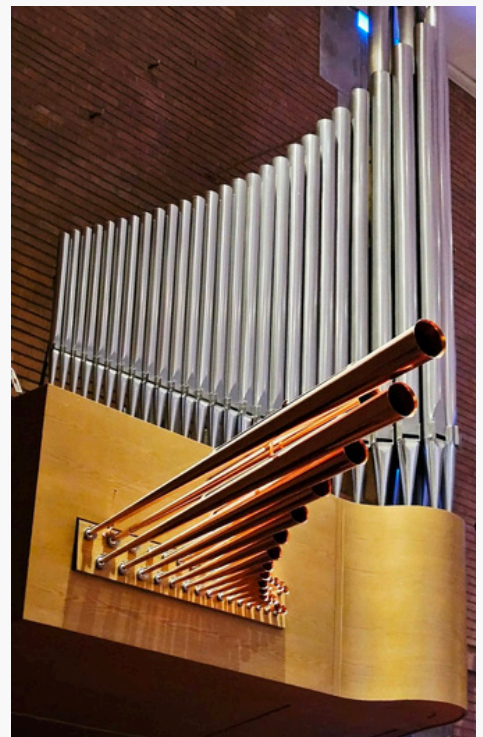
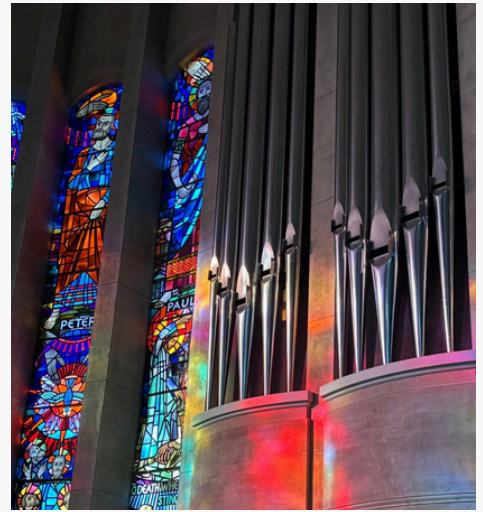
The sanctuary is crowned by a 76-rank Casavant pipe organ installed in 2013 and designed to support both congregational worship and concert performance. The instrument regularly supports major choral works, orchestra collaborations, recital performances, and worship leadership in one of the most acoustically resonant sacred spaces in the St. Louis region.

MARTIN OTT TRACKER ORGAN

A Martin Ott tracker organ in the chapel (1 manual / 11 ranks) offers additional opportunities for repertoire, continuo work, and intimate worship experiences.

STEINWAY GRAND PIANO

Our sanctuary Steinway provides exceptional resources for accompanying, recital work, chamber collaborations and worship leadership.



A SANCTUARY BUILT FOR MUSIC

The sanctuary features thirteen soaring stained-glass windows that fill the room with remarkable color and light. Musicians regularly describe the space as inspiring, warm, and acoustically alive.

The sanctuary's warmth, resonance, and beauty make it a preferred performance venue for organizations including the Metropolitan Orchestra of St. Louis, St. Louis Civic Orchestra, Bach Society of St. Louis, and Chamber Music Society of St. Louis.

- Accompany the Chancel Choir rehearsal on Thursday evenings
- Accompany the Chancel Choir Sunday mornings at 11:00 a.m.
- Serve as worship organist at least twice a month
- Serve as organist with the Christmas Concert and Good Friday orchestras
- Accompany Christmas Eve 2:00 and 10:00 p.m. worship services
- Play memorial services and weddings as scheduled with the Director of Music Ministries (additional compensation)
- Serve as organist and Chancel Choir director when the Director of Music Ministries is on vacation/away
- Welcome/assist guest concerts and musicians as needed (Con Spirito and others)
